# DEVELOPED ACTIVITIES BY IETT, 2023

In achieving its objectives, IETT has developed a diverse activity in various fields, such as: scientific, cultural, research, publishing, information and documentation. The main groups of these activities are summarized in:

- **SCIENTIFIC - CULTURAL ORGANIZATIONS (CONFERENCES, SESSIONS, LECTURES ETC)**
- **TRAININGS IN DIFFERENT FIELDS**
- **PARTICIPATION IN CONFERENCES, SEMINARS, VISITS, FAIRS INSIDE AND ABROAD**

## Summarized activities in a non-chronological way :

- The Institute of Education, Heritage, and Tourism (IETT) organized a two-day international conference in Ulcinj, Montenegro, on the topic: "Identity issues and Heritage Practices" in collaboration with the Center for Advanced Studies (CNS) in Bosnia & Herzegovina; AIITC in Tirana; with the support of IIIT, USA, and "Horizonti," Montenegro.
- In the framework of the cycle of meetings for knowing Albanian cultural and natural heritage, IETT organized a lecture with museologist Inesa Sulaj on the topic: "The State of Museums in Albania and Audience Engagement"
- IETT offered scholarships up to 100% for Bachelor and Master Programs in the fields of Economics and Computer Engineering in collaboration with CIT University.
- The Institute of Education, Heritage and Tourism held the meeting of the Board of Directors, to analyze the activity of 2023. Among the points that were discussed and unanimously approved were the appointment of Prof. Dr. Nevila Nika as the Executive Director of IETT for 2024 and beyond.
- IETT was part of the National Internship Program under Call VIII of the National Program of Work Practices announced by the Minister of State for Youth and Children.
- A delegation from IETT organized a meeting with the Director of the Library at the National State Archives of EBA in Abu Dhabi. In this meeting, the areas of cooperation between the two institutions were discussed.
- IETT and CIT HUB as part of the project "Improving Digital Skills through Innovative Centers", supported by the National Youth Congress in cooperation with the Municipality of Tirana, organized a workshop on Cyber security.
- The Institute of Education, Heritage and Tourism had the pleasure to certify the students Selma Bërxulli and Igli Jasimi, who successfully completed 3 months internship at the institute's premises, in the field of cultural heritage and tourism. They gained skills and preparation for the job market, as well as work experience in an institution.
- IETT paid a visit at the Women's Museum in Tirana, where they were welcomed by the founder Mrs. Elsa Ballauri, who made a presentation of the museum and its activities. Possibilities for collaboration in organizing activities, events, open lectures, etc., to promote the heritage and historical-cultural values of Albania were also discussed.
- In the framework of the 47th anniversary of the commemoration of the Palestinian land day, IETT participated in the reception of Palestine Embassy, dedicated to this day.
- IETT participated in the opening ceremony of the exhibition: "The Contribution of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia in the Service of Islam and Muslims", where it was introduced to Arab heritage, culture and art. In the framework of promoting the culture, heritage and tourist sites of our country, IETT participated for



the fourth year in the 11th edition of the international Travel and Tourism Fair in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia. This fair is considered one of the largest leading fairs in the field of tourism, both locally and internationally.

- The Director of IETT, Prof. Zekaj paid visits to the University of Business and Technology and the University of Science and Technology, KAUST, Jeddah. During these visits, discussions revolved around potential collaborations in the field of education. Additionally, the latest IETT publications were gifted to the libraries of these universities.
- IETT participated in the conference on the theme: "Creating learning landscapes through heritage interpretation", organized by Interpret Europe in Romania.
- A delegation from IETT visited the "Women's Museum" in Dubai, where they were welcomed by its founder, Dr. Rafia Ghubash. This museum reveals the values and achievements of Emirati women over the years.
- Another visit was made to the National Archives Museum in Abu Dhabi, where the traditional was combined with the latest visual presentation technology for showcasing objects, history, and more.
- IETT closely followed the International Tourism Convention, co-organized for the first time in the Balkans with the World Tourism Organization.
- The Director of IETT paid a visit to the '29 May University' in Istanbul, where he was welcomed by the Rector, Prof. Dr. Mustafa Sinanoglu. During this meeting, various collaborations in the field of Education, joint publications, and other areas were discussed.
- The Institute of Education, Heritage and Tourism has signed a cooperation agreement with Bassera Group, during the visit to Jeddah, Saudi Arabia, in the field of Education and Tourism. The collaboration includes summer camps for students, training in heritage and tourism, technology-related training, and the preparation of mutual cultural tours to enhance cultural understanding between the two countries.
- IETT also visited various museums and cultural centers such as the Museum of Islamic Art in Jeddah, the Center for Cultural Understanding, SMCCU in Dubai, etc. Discussions during these visits explored potential collaborations in areas of mutual interest.
- Several visits were also made to other universities and schools where various projects in the field of education of all levels were discussed.

## DEVELOPED ACTIVITIES BY IETT, 2022

- The Institute of Education, Heritage and Tourism became part of the program "Tirana European Youth Capital 2022" with "CIT HUB - Innovation Center" project, in cooperation with the University College "Canadian Institute of Technology" and financed by the National Youth Congress and the Municipality of Tirana.
- IETT organized the international conference on the theme: "Islamic Literature in the Albanian Language 1945-2022", in cooperation with the Center for Advanced Studies, Sarajevo; AIITC, Tirana and the Cultural Center 'Horizonti', Podgorica.
- During the visit paid to "Ali Iber Neza" high school in Tropoja, a contingent of books of different genres was donated to the school library.
- In the framework of cooperation agreement with CIT University, at the beginning of the new academic year, IETT offered scholarships up to 100% for Bachelor and Master programs in the fields of Economics and Computer Engineering.
- IETT, with the support of UBA Bank, CIT University and "Mileniumi i Ri" Printing House, successfully organized the photo competition: "Treasures of Albania".
- During the awards distribution ceremony of photography competition, a lecture was held by Prof. Dr. Valter Shtylla on the topic: "Photographic Art and Cultural Heritage".
- IETT, during the visit to "Thimi Mitko" library in Korça, donated a series of publications for the readers. The importance of contributions to the institutions' libraries was discussed as an investment in the education of the younger generations, as well as about the possibilities of cooperation.
- In the framework of the "Egyptian Culture Week", IETT organized an open lecture on Egypt-Albania relations, with the special participation of the Ambassador of Egypt in Tirana, Sh.T.Z. Mohamed Heider, along with other members of the Egyptian Embassy, professors, researchers, and students.
- IETT supported the organization of the international conference, ICITTB 2022.
- The Department of Education and Tourism organized a 2-week summer camp with educational and entertainment activities for children aged 9-13.
- We welcomed in Tirana the professional photographer, researcher and documenter of flora and fauna in our lands, Arian Mavriqi, in order to present and recognize our natural heritage.
- The Department of Education at IETT, in cooperation with the University College "Canadian Institute of Technology" (CIT), organized a two-day training in "Digital & Internet Marketing" with the lecturers, Dr. Enriko Ceko and Dr. Oriola Musa. They addressed theoretical topics such as the role of advertising and other promotional elements of marketing, the evolution of integrated marketing communication (IMC) concept, the increasing value of IMC in advertising and promotion programs, etc.
- In the framework of the "CIT HUB - Innovation Center" project, a series of trainings were developed in programs such as Python, Web Developer, Office Packages, CITi Incubator Start Up, Database Management, and also was organised the DemoDay StartUp Challenge 2022.
- IETT offered an internship for "International Relations and Communication" to the master's student, Ms. Arwa Mufaku, making her part of several international activities of IETT.
- -A study visit to the "Divjakë-Karavasta" National Park and the Belshi lakes was another organization of IETT for students, specialists and other interested young people. Its main purpose was the study and recognition of their scientific, natural, tourist and economic values. They were led by specialists Xhulia Bygjymi and Dritan Lloçi, geographers/GIS specialists.
- The Department of Education at IETT developed preparatory courses for the TOEFL exam and the IELTS exam.
- Also, free English lessons were offered to the graduates, with the aim of repeating the main knowledge for achieving high results in the State Matura Exam of the English subject.

- "Smart Cultural Tourism as a Promoter of Sustainable Development in Albania" was the topic addressed at the international conference on cultural tourism in Europe on the topic: "Relaunching European Tourism through Cultural Heritage & Digitalization", held in Krk/Rijeka, Croatia organized by European Cultural Tourism Network, ECTN.

## DEVELOPED ACTIVITIES BY IETT, 2020-2021 and past years

- International Conference "Teaching Social Sciences and Humanities in the Balkan Madrasas"  
This conference was organized under the coordination of IETT Tirana and the Center for Advanced Studies (CNS), Sarajevo in cooperation with AIITC, Tirana, Center for Intercultural Understanding "Horizon", Podgorica and IIIT, USA. The aim was to shed light on the inclusion of the humanities and social sciences in the curricula of Balkan madrasas and their current status.
- International workshop "Research Coaching Program" Training on research methods for researchers which lasted for a period of 6 months. This project supported a group of 12 selected applicants from Albania, Kosovo, Montenegro and Northern Macedonia.

Present in this event was the author of the book, Mr. Najwan Darwish, a well-known poet from Palestine. The participants received a copy of the book signed by the author.

The session was led by the lecturer PhD. Bledar Kazia. The purpose of this training was to teach the participants other additional details related to Google tools such as: Calendar, Meet, Chat, Drive, Docs, Sheets, Slides, Forms, Sites and others.
- Training : "Informatized Accounting - Financa 5" IETT organized training sessions "Informatized Accounting - Finance 5" led by PhD (c) Gjergji Tafa.
- Open lecture with students from University of Korça, UNIKO on the topic: "Tour Operator". IETT in collaboration with the touristic agency "Balkan Pearls Tour Operator" and the Faculty of Economy, Marketing-Tourism Department at UNIKO developed the open lecture hour "Tour operator".
- Training: "Management of a Web page" This training was led by Muhamedali Kura, program engineer and data architect. Students had the opportunity to apply their knowledge and at the same time gain experience by creating and managing a new web page.
- Internship for Students in Full Stack Development IETT, in the framework of the application of the knowledge obtained during the studies, as the path to career development, organized the internship

in Social Media Marketing. Students of the Canadian Institute of Technology, CIT over three months put their ideas into practice.

- Historical-cultural tour for students. IETT in cooperation with “Balkan Pearls Tour Operator” organized for the students of the Canadian Institute of Technology (CIT), the historical-cultural tour that included southeastern Albania, such as Korca, Pogradec, Tushemisht, Lake Prespa and parts of northern Macedonia such as Struga and Ohrid.
- Summer Camp The Department of Education and Tourism at IETT in cooperation with the center "Millennium", Durrës offered for children aged 7-13 years a 14-day summer camp, full of fun, educational activities in foreign languages, new friendships, literary classes, theater , 6 excursions to different places in Albania, etc.
- Participation in the scientific conference “Balkans Between European Integration and Regional Cooperation” The Director of IETT, Prof. Ass. Dr. Ramiz Zekaj presented his paper on the topic: "Inter-religious Relations in the Balkans and Multiculturalism in the EU". This conference aimed to highlight the human aspects of rapprochement between peoples, through the competition of knowledge and scientific research.
- International Seminar on the Project "Excellent" IETT participated in the seminar of October 28, 2021 in Tirana, organized by the Regional Center for Cooperation and Development. The seminar aimed to create a cross-border network of sustainable tourism as well as the management and marketing of lesser-known destinations on the Italy-Albania-Montenegro cross-border.
- Participation in the webinar of Interpret Europe – Integration of Interpretation in Parks IETT as a member of Interpret Europe, participated in the next webinar on the topic: Integration of interpretation in parks.
- Participation in the webinar of Interpret Europe: Combining Interpret Europe Trainings with National Certification Systems During the meeting, members of other international organizations shared different experiences from trainings conducted by EI in their country. Ideas for combining training with other assessment systems for guides were also discussed.
- Participation in the Webinar of Interpret Europe “Museums through online days - Dedication, Truthfulness, Distance” IETT as a member of Interpret Europe participated in the webinar ‘Museums through online days - dedication, truthfulness, distance’.
- Participation in the conference: Recreating tourism through Interpretation of heritage IETT shared its experience as the organizer of the IE Certified Interpretative Guide (CIG) training, held in Tirana.
- Participation in the International Conference: “Handicrafts and Trade in Presevo Valley and in Albanian Territories” IETT was represented in this scientific conference with the topic: "Socio-cultural effects of handicrafts in Presevo and the surrounding area" by the director of IETT, Prof. As. Dr. Ramiz Zekaj.
